Dear Colleagues,

Further to Bishop Mary's email of March 4<sup>th</sup>, a reminder that parishes wishing to ask for exemption to hold in-person Holy Week and Easter Services should be in touch with me at your convenience.

Please be reminded that any in-person worship will need to follow current health guidelines and diocesan guidelines, which include:

- the use of masks for all worshipping (surgical/medical masks the blue or black disposable ones are being recommended by the province for everyone at this point)
- maximum of 10 persons TOTAL
- physical distancing
- use of cantor (who is exercising additional physical distancing from everyone else)
- no congregational singing
- washing/sanitizing of hands
- log of those persons attending (for contact tracing)
- Eucharist shared in one kind (strongly recommended that it be distributed to the congregation present in their seat to minimize movement)
- curfew of 8pm

Parishes who have already applied and been given permission to re-open in the past and who have already had Phase III practices, may be in touch with me to discuss this exemption during Holy Week and Easter.
