APPLICATION FORM

PARISH/CONGREGATIONAL LOANS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS

Low-interest loans (interest rates will be determined annually by the Standing Committee on Finance) will be made available to parishes/congregations in need of financial assistance for the purposes of improving, renovating, repurposing and redevelopment of church buildings. The Loans Committee is particularly interested in supporting:

- Projects that will help the parish/congregation expand its mission and ministry,
- New and imaginative projects that might have difficulty in finding financial help,
- Projects that can be replicated and shared with others.

Funding is not awarded for the purchase of or repairs to church organs or other musical instruments, for the installation of stained glass windows, for operating budgets, bridge financing, salaries, or travel expenses. An application for a project that has already been completed, or in progress, will normally not be considered.

CRITERIA FOR AWARDING LOANS

The parish or congregation shall demonstrate the following:

- 1. That the project is mission-oriented (with particular reference to the Marks of Mission) and is consistent with the Ministry Action Plan of the diocese.
- 2. That it is ready for the undertaking. The Committee will consider the congregation's health (attendance, identifiable givers, annual givings), vision & plan for ministry, leadership, administrative capacity, facilities and property.
- 3. A good knowledge of their neighbourhood, community, village, etc. and how the project connects with this context.
- 4. A commitment to sound financial management and stewardship in the parish/congregation and the capacity of the parish to repay a loan. (Parishes/congregations are encouraged to repay their loans as soon as possible in order that the funds repaid may be available for loans to others.)
- 5. How the project will enable the parish/congregation to flourish.
- 6. How the project will be self-sustaining at the end of the funding period.
- 7. The parish/congregation shall also apply (where appropriate) for an Anglican Foundation grant. For information on applying, go to http://www.anglicanfoundation.org/
