

Day 1: Friday, May 29: MONTREAL

Depart from Montreal at 7pm on Air Canada, arriving in Toronto at 8:24pm. Depart Toronto at 11:10pm and fly non-stop to Lisbon.

Day 2: Saturday, May 30: LISBON

Welcome to Lisbon arriving at 11:10am. We will meet our English-speaking tour escort upon arrival, then travel together by coach to our hotel. Balance of the day at leisure to explore. Before dinner, we will gather together to celebrate the Eucharist and give thanks for this opportunity of pilgrimage.

Dinner/overnight at the Marriott Hotel, Lisbon.

Day 3: Sunday, May 31: LISBON

Today we will join the local Anglican community for the celebration of the Eucharist at St. George's Anglican Church.

We will also have a half day city orientation tour with a local guide viewing the highlights of the city followed by some free time to explore Lisbon on your own.

Dinner/overnight at the Marriott Hotel, Lisbon.

Day 4: Monday, June 1: FATIMA/PORTO

After breakfast we drive to Fatima (128Km) and will dedicate the day to viewing the sanctuary and places related to the apparitions and the lives of Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta, the three seers of Fatima. This will include the Chapel of the Apparitions, built atop the site of the holm oak tree where the Blessed Mother appeared.

View Valinhos, a religious countryside place on the outskirts of Fátima. This place became famous for the 19th August 1917 apparition of Our Lady of Fátima and by the 1st and 3rd apparitions of the Guardian Angel of Portugal. Visit the Basilica of Fatima and the Residence of Francisco and Jacinta Marte.

We continue to Porto (197km) and on arrival we will have the balance of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the HF Ipanema Park Hotel, Porto.





Day 5: Tuesday, June 2: PORTO

After breakfast we will have a half day tour of Porto including a Douro 6 Bridges Boat Cruise Follow in the footsteps of the wine merchants of Portugal on a classic "Six Bridges" cruise of Porto. Sail down the River Douro along the route of the old "Rabello Boats" that served Porto and Vila Nova de Gaia which includes red or white port wine. Following the cruise our guide will take us on a short city tour. The balance of the day in the afternoon will be at leisure to explore the city.

Dinner and overnight at the HF Ipanema Park Hotel, Porto

Day 6: Wednesday, June 3: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

After breakfast we drive to Santiago de Compostela (232 km). On arrival to this amazing pilgrimage city we will visit the magnificent Baroque Cathedral where pilgrims from around the globe come to reach their final destination in the historic Plaza del Obradoiro. Once through its main entrance, the "Gateway of Glory", we will be greeted by the same spectacle that pilgrims have experienced since the Middle Ages. The apostle James, the patron saint

of Spain, is buried in the Cathedral here. After visiting the Cathedral, we will explore some of the narrow streets and old squares of the compact city centre.

Dinner and overnight at the Compostela Hotel, Santiago de Compostela





Day 7: Thursday, June 4: MADRID

We depart for our bus journey to the Capital of Spain, Madrid (600 km's).

On arrival in Madrid in the late afternoon you will have free time at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at the Senator Gran Via 70 Spa Hotel, Madrid.

Day 8: Friday, June 5: MADRID/TOLEDO

This morning you will have a half day orientation tour of Madrid viewing all the major highlights of this amazing city before driving to the city of Toledo for a city tour and visit to the Primada Cathedral and Museum. Toledo's illustrious main church ranks among the top 10

cathedrals in Spain. An impressive example of medieval Gothic architecture, its enormous interior is full of the classic characteristics of the style, rose windows, flying buttresses, ribbed vaults and pointed arches among them. It is the seat of the Metropolitan Archdiocese of Toledo. Return to Madrid.

Dinner and overnight at the Senator Gran Via 70 Spa Hotel, Madrid.

Day 9: Saturday, June 6: PAMPLONA

After breakfast drive to Pamplona (392km). On arrival in the afternoon a half day orientation tour of this town. Pamplona is the capital of Navarre province in northern Spain. It's best known for the Running of the Bulls (Feast of San Fermín) in July. During this legendary multiday festival, bulls are led through the city streets by daredevil runners.

Pamplona is actually surrounded by some of the best preserved city walls in Europe. The original walls and fortifications date as far back as Roman times, but the ones we see standing today were renovated in 1530 during the reign of King Carlos V.

Dinner and overnight at the Tres Reyes Hotel, Pamplona.





Day 10: Sunday, June 7: BARCELONA

We depart Pamplona after breakfast and drive to Barcelona (485km). On arrival in the afternoon we will have an orientation tour of the city. Barcelona is the cosmopolitan capital of Spain's Catalonia region and known for its art and architecture.

Dinner and overnight at the Medinaceli Hotel, Barcelona

Day 11: Monday, June 8: BARCELONA

This morning we have a half day tour of Barcelona visiting the Sagrada Familia, one of the most famous landmarks in the city. It has been in construction since 1882 and is supposed to be completed in 2026. The famous architect Antoni Gaudi took over the architectural leadership of this church till his death in 1926. We will continue on to visit the Park Guell designed by Antoni Gaudi which is a UNESCO Heritage site. The park contains amazing stone structures, stunning tiling and fascinating buildings.

The balance of the day is at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at the Medinaceli Hotel, Barcelona

Day 12: Tuesday, June 9: BARCELONA/ MONTSERRAT

We drive this morning to Montserrat for a half day tour. Montserrat is a spectacularly beautiful Benedictine monk mountain retreat. Visit the Montserrat Monastery to see the statue of the Black Madonna, patron saint of Catalonia. The 12th-century figure is enthroned above the high altar in the basilica of the monastery. In her honor the "Escolania de Montserrat", consisting of about 50 choirboys from the boarding school of the monastery church sings songs daily - Salve Regina and Virolai.

Return to Barcelona and the balance of the day at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at the Medinaceli Hotel, Barcelona

Day 13: Wednesday, June 10: BARCELONA/MONTREAL

Transfer this morning to Barcelona Airport for your Air Canada flight departing at 11:45am flying to Toronto non-stop arriving at 2:45pm.

In Toronto connect to your Air Canada flight to Montreal departing at 5:00pm and arriving in Montreal at 6:15pm.

Please send in your application, copy of the *picture page* of your passport, and \$300 deposit to Archdeacon Robert Camara by *January 31, 2020*. (Note: you will also be required to submit proof of health insurance for travel prior to departure.)

The rates are per person in Canadian Dollars based on double occupancy.
Based on a minimum of 20 paying passengers: \$4,249 per person
Single Supplement: \$950 (for those who want their own room).


